

Support for Obtaining PPE



For level 2 medical masks:

The City will continue to provide masks to Drop-Ins. If an organization needs to change aspects/quantities of masks for whatever reason, they should contact Allison Wilson: Allison.Wilson@toronto.ca with their organization name, full project location address, reason for change, and amount of masks needed.

If your hours of operation have changed then you should include that for delivery logistics. If you are new drop ins who have not received masks previously from the City, Allison can help you sign up.

For level 3 medical masks, KN95s, eye protection, gloves, gowns, hand sanitizer, and cleaning and disinfecting wipes:



You can now request personal protective equipment (PPE) and critical supplies <u>at no cost</u> through Stream 3 of the Government of Canada's <u>Essential Services Contingency Reserve</u> (ESCR):

• **Step 1:** Register your organization by completing the <u>online registration form</u>.



- **Step 2:** Once you are notified that your registration has been approved, you will also receive login credentials to access the <u>online catalogue</u> and request the critical supplies your organization requires.
- **Step 3:** You will receive the status of your request by email and be asked to confirm that you are ordering the approved supplies.

Once your organization's application is accepted, your request may be accepted in full or in part based on the availability of requested supplies. Please note that the Government of Canada reserves the right to limit quantities if necessary. Supplies are available on a "first-come, first-served" basis.

For N95 Masks and Rapid Antigen Tests:

• To support the demand of N95 1870+ masks by primary care providers and smaller-sized organizations, smaller packages of the product are now available for ordering.



- Other N95 models are also available for order if required however, there are in limited supply.
